Discipleship is like love. Everyone believes in the concept, but far less agree on how to go about achieving it in real life. As a result, many books on discipleship start with a group of disconnected verses before launching into the author's own how-to program for making disciples. A few should even come with Solomon's warning in Ecclesiastes 12:12. "Of making many books there is no end, and much study wearies the body."

With that sense of wariness and weariness, I approached Grant Kaul's book on *LIFE-Giving Discipleship*. But something in the Introduction piqued my interest. This wasn't a how-to book offering a recipe for producing cookie-cutter disciples with a few Bible verses mixed in for good measure. It's an exposition of 2 Timothy—Paul's final letter where he reached out to help his young disciple Timothy grow in his faith and reproduce that faith in others. Grant's guidebook on discipleship turned out to be an insightful commentary on 2 Timothy *and* a practical guide for taking people today through the process of becoming disciples of Christ.

What I liked best was that Grant continually kept my focus on THE Book! By taking readers through the Book of 2 Timothy applicationally, Grant offers a guidebook on discipleship and spiritual growth that flows directly from the pen of the apostle Paul himself. As I said earlier, many books on discipleship should come with Solomon's words of warning from Ecclesiastes 12:12. Thankfully, *LIFE-Giving Discipleship* more closely aligns with Solomon's timely words one verse earlier. "The words of the wise are like goads, their collected sayings like firmly embedded nails—given by one Shepherd" (v. 11).

Grant set out to produce a skill-based guidebook for a lifetime of spiritual growth and influence. By aligning the guidebook with the final words of Paul in 2 Timothy, he has succeeded!
